Newcastle and Districts Four Wheel Drive Club Inc. is an Association bound by State legislation. The Club is affiliated with both *Four Wheel Drive NSW & ACT* and *Four Wheel Drive Australia*. Objectives include promotion of 4WD touring as a legitimate form of recreation, to educate the public and other 4WD users in the correct use of their vehicles, in caring and respecting the environment. Thus, all members are required to abide with our Constitution & By-Laws, and the Codes of Conduct issued by *Four Wheel Drive Australia*.

The Club has a strong commitment to responsible & safe four wheel driving. Unless exempted by the Committee, new members are required to participate in our Basic Driver Awareness program at the earliest opportunity. Vehicles participating in 4WD activities must have adequate recovery points and, within a reasonable period, minimum basic equipment of 8000kg snatch strap, snatch strap damper, two “D” or Bow shackles rated at 3.5 or 4.75T WLL, shovel, gloves, tyre pressure gauge and first aid kit.

UHF CB radio, either mobile (installed in vehicle) or hand held is used for communication on Club trips. Participation in club 4WD trips is an excellent way to enjoy our wide country and further driving or other 4WD related skills. 'Advice' given by Trip Leaders or other members indicates what they would do in the same situation. The decision to follow such 'advice' is the choice of the recipient.

To become a member: You must have a road registered Four Wheel Drive or All Wheel Drive vehicle with either comprehensive or third party property insurance. You must attend three club events including at least one 4WD trip - this allows you to get the feel of the club and the members. If you wish to continue, complete your application and submit it to the Secretary by hand or mail to the address above. You will be advised when the Committee approves your application and membership will commence.
